Pete McIllwain is an internationally recognized expert in intelligence, security, counterintelligence and counter-terrorist operations and related foreign affairs matters. As an independent consultant he travels abroad frequently to service contracts with a range of government and private clients in Europe, Africa, Asia, and the Middle East. He is also a Partner and Vice President of a defense company in Virginia, which designs and manufactures technologically advanced security and intelligence related hardware.
